Score Reporting

Both coaches (winning and losing) must sign the game card after the game. The winning coach keeps the game card and then reports the score via the WASA Website by Tuesday at 5pm or there will be a 1 point deduction in the standings. If the game is being played on a Wed, Thur or Friday you have 48 hours after game completion to report the score. In the case of a **tie game** the home team is responsible for reporting the game score and keeping the score card. Failure in reporting score will result in a 1 point deduction in the standings.
